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5 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
6 THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE RATIFYING EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

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8 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 533 empowers the Director of Emergency Services of the
9 County of Riverside to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a Local Emergency when the
10 County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the County Board of Supervisors is not
11 in session, subject to the ratification by the County Board of Supervisors within seven (7) days; and

12 WHEREAS, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within
13 the County of Riverside caused by extreme winter weather, snow, rain, and a melting snowpack that
14 occurred on March 21, 2023; and,

15 WHEREAS, additional storms are expected to come into the County this week and in the
16 foreseeable future that are capable of exacerbating damage to flood control and critical infrastructure due
17 to more rainfall on the oversaturated ground and melting snow; and,

18 WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services of the County of Riverside did proclaim the
19 existence of a Local Emergency within said County on the 30th day of March; now, therefore,

20 IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the proclamation of a Local Emergency by
21 the Director of Emergency Services of the County of Riverside is hereby ratified, and that said Local
22 Emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the County Board
23 of Supervisors of the County of Riverside.
