The data you are providing will be used to help validate our process and reports. Your feedback and submissions are very important to REMSA. BLS providers: I am working with some of the agencies to determine a reporting structure that suits the needs of your services, if you have any feedback please contact me so we may have a discussion on the matter. These measures are pulled from the EMSA Core Measure project. Currently they only apply to ALS providers. Hospitals please continue to use the CARES registry as your reporting forum. I have shared all of the needed reports in Image Trend Report Writer under the "QA/QI" folder. I would like your feedback on the reports and their criteria. When you are submitting the data, if you believe you are getting accurate consistent data then provide that comment, in the comment box, if there are other criteria that could be added or deleted to improve the quality of the data collected then under the "Image Trend comments box." Please provide the specific values you would like to see added or have used in an addition to. Please provide this data and all of your feedback by October 31, 2018. If you are unable to do so by this timeframe please contact me. If you have any questions please contact me.
