SUBJECT:	Ambulance Patient Offload Delay (APOD) Ambulance Redirection
DATE:	March 20, 2019

The Riverside County EMS Agency (REMSA) is closely monitoring^a the impact of Ambulance Patient Offload Time/Delay (APOT/APOD)^b performance at Riverside Community Hospital (RCH). RCH is experiencing significant and abnormal APODs that are negatively impacting the EMS system. Focused on patient safety, REMSA is immediately activating <u>Provisional Policy 6104</u> to better coordinate and manage EMS patient destinations primarily within the Northwest EMS Zone. Provisional Policy 6104 will remain active countywide for the next 90 days and may be renewed as needed to manage the EMS system.
