SUBJECT: Public Comments on EMS System Reports

Through a multi-agency collaborative effort, the Riverside County Emergency Medical Services System consolidated its EMS providers under a single, unified electronic patient reporting system in July 2017. This multi-agency approach is helping standardize EMS practices in Riverside County and has produced over two years of pre-hospital data collected and maintained in a single data source. The Riverside County EMS Agency (REMSA) administers this dataset and has constructed a data reporting strategy to provide the EMS system with pertinent reporting to help drive best practices, quality improvement, and education. To begin an anticipated series of reporting requests for its stakeholders, the Riverside County EMS Agency (REMSA) is releasing the following draft reports for public comment:

- 1. <u>Patient Care Continuum Report</u>: EMS response-time intervals across the pre-hospital patient care continuum
- 2. Emergency Medical Dispatch: EMD utilization and patient record integration in Riverside County
- 3. <u>WIC-5150 Impact Report</u>: WIC-5150 response within Riverside County's EMS system

Comments addressing report structure, utility, data content and accuracy, and proposed edits are requested.
