The Riverside County EMS Agency (REMSA), as part of the Medical Health Operational Area Coordinator (MHOAC) Program has activated the Medical and Health Communications Center to closely monitor the impacts associated with the current Red Flag/High Winds and potential SCE Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS). Additionally, the County of Riverside Emergency Operation Center (EOC) is activated at a management watch and is tracking all weather-related emergency response activity. If your facility and/or organization is impacted and require immediate assistance please coordinate with your local jurisdiction, utility provider and notify the REMSA Duty Officer. Please ensure that your administration and operations personnel are prepared to manage and communicate weather related impacts.
