To support the continued response activity surrounding the Covid-19 declared State of Emergency, and to mitigate the occurrence of Ambulance Patient Offload Delays (APOD) the Riverside County EMS Agency in partnership with the Medical and Health Operational Area Coordination Program officially requested assistance from the California Emergency Medical Services Authority (EMSA).

EMSA supported ALS transport resources will be deploying into Riverside County and incorporated into the 9-1-1 system and dispatched by American Medical Response as early as Saturday, January 29, 2022. Intermittent BLS resources will be deployed to prehospital receiving centers to help mitigate the occurrence of APOD. These resources will continue to monitor patients being offloaded so 9-1-1 system resources can return to service.
