REMSA has identified the following educational opportunities through our Unusual Occurrences reporting and review process. The purpose of this system advisory to increase awareness and encourage direct training and education as suggested below:

- 1- To avoid medication errors please remind field personnel to follow all important safety steps and utilize the calculation chart. Ensure that all personnel follow policy and procedures for administering medications and are familiar with the following:
 - Use of RIGHTS/DICE of medication administration
 - D-drug -correct one. I- Integrity packaging intact. C- color/concentration/clarity. Eexpiration.
 - o Right patient, right medication, right route, right dose, right time, right documentation
- 2- Please remind field personnel that APOD re-direct DOES NOT apply to any specialty care designated center for Stroke, STEMI, or Trauma for patient needing those specialty services. Always transport these patients to the closest most appropriate specialty center per policies 4502, 4401, and 4302.
