

Case Review Indicators

- A. Unanticipated Outcome with Opportunity for Improvement.
- B. Morbidity and mortality related to procedural complications.
- C. System Issues (i.e. diversion, transfer delays, policy limitations, etc.)
- D. Deviation from Policies and Protocols leading to poor patient outcome.
- E. Any additional cases needing further review or loop closure may be submitted.
 - Assigned centers to submit a minimum of 1 case from indicator A-E.
 - All cases must be redacted with unnecessary PHIremoved.
 - Cases must be submitted **two weeks prior** to Committee meeting.
 - All facilities and agencies involved in the case must be notified that the case is to be discussed at the system reviewcommittee.
 - A hospital rep. shall coordinate with the EMS agency to present pre-hospital care related to the case.
