As part of our commitment to keeping stakeholders informed, the Riverside County Emergency Management Department (EMD) is proactively notifying stakeholders regarding recent developments to the Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP). Initial information suggests that HPP grant funding will be reduced, which may affect some of the resources provided to the Riverside County Emergency Management Health Care Coalition (RCEMHCC).

Although funding levels remain uncertain, our commitment to supporting coalition members and safeguarding the health and safety of our community remains a top priority. EMD will focus on critical initiatives, advocate for continued funding, and seek opportunities to maximize local and regional resources. We encourage all organizations to remain engaged and provide input on priorities as we navigate potential changes.
